Racine County Parks proposes to install three rustic camping cabins within the existing campground to enhance and diversify overnight accommodation options available to park visitors. Each cabin will be modest in scale and designed to complement the natural character of the park. The structures will include basic furnishings such as beds, chairs, and a table, providing a simple and comfortable shelter for users seeking a more structured alternative to traditional tent camping.

Electrical service will be provided to each cabin to support basic lighting and limited power needs. In keeping with the campground's existing infrastructure, outdoor water spigots will be installed nearby and shared in a manner consistent with other campsites within the park. No individual plumbing or sanitary facilities are proposed within the cabins.

The cabins and associated parking area will be located within the footprint of the former "Group Site One," which has been decommissioned and is no longer in active use. Utilizing this previously disturbed area minimizes environmental impacts and avoids expansion into undeveloped portions of the park. Site access, circulation, and parking will be designed to integrate with the existing campground layout.

This project is intended to expand recreational opportunities by introducing a new lodging option that appeals to a broader range of users, including families and individuals who may not have traditional camping equipment. The addition of rustic cabins is expected to increase campground utilization, extend seasonal use, and enhance the overall visitor experience while maintaining the park's natural setting and character.
