Heckel Properties LLC owns the subject property and wants to create an additional lot.



Jurisdiction The subject property is located entirely within the Town's zoning jurisdiction. It is located within 1.5 miles of the Village of Eagle, requiring its review and approval.

Layout Both of the proposed lots comply with the minimum lot area of 40,000 square feet, frontage requirements of 35 feet, and minimum lot width of 150 feet and 190 feet for corner lots. The existing building in Lot 1 complies with the minimum side yard offset of 20 feet and maximum building coverage of 50 percent.

Public notice Aside from being shown on a published meeting agenda, no other public notice is required.

Review procedure The Plan Commission makes a recommendation to the Town Board, which has final review authority.

Potential motion for Plan Commission: Approve the conceptual design of the two-lot CSM, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The layout of the lots in the final CSM must substantially comply with the layout depicted in the conceptual CSM.
- 2. The final CSM must comply with the Town's land division regulations, and any requirements in ch. 236, Wis. Stats.
- 3. The Town Engineer must review the CSM and approve of the same.
- 4. The petitioner must obtain all necessary approvals as specified in s. 236.34(1), Wis. Stats. (County approval).

- 5. The petitioner must provide documentation from Waukesha County showing that there is a suitable site on Lot 2 for a septic system.
- 6. The petitioner must provide documentation from Waukesha County (Preliminary Site Evaluation) showing that the septic system for the existing building on Lot 1 is located entirely within the proposed lot and complies with setback requirements from the adjoining lot.
- 7. The surveyor's seal, signature, and date must appear on all sheets of the final CSM. The same revision date must also be noted on each sheet.

Motion for Town Board: Motion to accept the recommendation of the Plan Commission.

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
