**Overview**: The Town of Mukwonago may allow a property owner to install a holding tank for an existing building when Waukesha County Division of Environmental Health determines a traditional septic cannot be installed because of unsuitable soils or other similar limitation.

Governing regulations: The procedures and standards governing holding tanks are found in Chapter 74 of the Town's municipal code.
