Section 36-686(d) of the Town's zoning code allows the use of a recreational vehicle for up to six months provided the people living in the RV own the property and the temporary waste disposal and water supply facilities for the property have been approved by the county health department.

**Possible Town Board motion**: Motion to allow the occupancy of a camper for no more than 6 months, commencing on the date the camper is placed on the subject property, provided occupancy is limited to Gregg and Lisa Jablonowski and their immediate family members and Waukesha County provides written documentation to the Town's building inspector regarding the adequacy of the temporary waste disposal and water supply facilities.
