All site plans must include the following:

- 1. Site Plan drawn to scale on an engineering survey (e.g., CSM, Plat of Survey), including scale and magnetic north.
- 2. Name of Project.
- 3. Architect's and/or engineer's name and address.
- 4. Date of Plan Submittal.
- 5. Existing topography shown at a contour interval not less than two (2) feet.
- 6. Proposed changes to topography.
- 7. Type, size, location and dimensions of all structures including fences and walls.
- 8. Location of parking, loading and storage areas.
- 9. Primary building materials.
- 10. Location of existing and proposed utilities.
- 11. Location of existing or proposed stormwater management areas.
- 12. Location of proposed solid waste storage areas and containers.
- 13. Location of pedestrian ways.
- 14. Existing and proposed public right-of-way widths and street names.
- 15. Location, type, height and intensity of proposed lighting.
- 16. Location of existing trees and landscaping.
- 17. Landscape plan (per Section 13.1104(c) of the Municipal Code).
- 18. Grading and Stormwater Management Plan.
- 19. Erosion control plan, including location of fences, etc.
- 20. A graphic delineation of any planned development staging.
- 21. Architectural Plans, elevations, and perspective drawings illustrating proposed structures.
- 22. Soil characteristics.
- 23. Completed Application for Site Plan Review.
- 24. Review fees as required in Chapter 42 of the Municipal Code.
- 25. Any other information which the applicant or City Staff believes will assist the Plan Commission in making a determination and recommendation on the proposal.

- Estimated Utility requirements (electrical, sewer treatment, water usage)
- Types of materials and equipment stored on site.
