Overview: Upon written petition, the Plan Commission may, on a case-by-case basis, grant a special exception for those development standards specifically noted as special exceptions in the zoning code. (See section 3 of this application for a listing). In making its decision, the Plan Commission and Town Board must consider a variety of factors. General evaluation criteria apply to all special exceptions and special evaluation criteria may also apply.

Governing regulations. The procedures and standards governing the review of this application are found in Article 6 of the Town's zoning code.

An invoice number will be provided to you after the initial intake review to pay the required application fee. A Professional Reimbursement Form is required prior to the application being considered complete.

The Town Planner can also review your application before it is formally submitted to determine if it is complete and provides enough information to describe the circumstances related to this application. 3. Whether there are any unique circumstances and the nature of those circumstances that warrant the issuance of the special exception.

I WAS NOT ALLOWED TO PUT MY DRIVEWAY ENTRANCE ON SPRANUE RD WHICH IS THE DIRECTION THE FRONT OF MY HOUSE PACES. BECAUSE I HAVE A CORNER LOT AND MY DRIVEWAY ENTERS FROM PRAIRIE PARMS COURT, THE SIDE OF MY HOUSE IS CONSIDERED THE FRONT. THIS MAKES MY GARGE LOCATION IN FRONT OF MY HOUSE,

4. The nature and extent of anticipated impacts to the natural environment that could potentially occur if the special exception was granted.

IMPACT ON THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT WOULD BE MINIMAL AS THE CLEARING OF TREES WOULD BE ONLY WHERE THE GAMMAE WOULD BE, THE TREES BEING REMOVED ARE BUCKTHORN, AND BRUSH, LOCATION IS CHOSEN TO AVOID CUTTING OAK TREES AND HICKORY TREES AND TO SAVE SLOW GROWING HANDWOODS.

5. The nature and extent of anticipated positive and negative effects on properties in the area

I DON'T SEE MAY NEGATIVE EFFECTS BY ALLOWING THIS EXCEPTION, CARE HAS BEEN TAKEN TO AVOID CUTTING SLOW GROWTH ONES, HICKORY AND WALNUT TREES ON MY PROPERTY. I HAVE REMOVED BUCKTHORN TO PROMOTE GROWTH OF HARDWOOD TREES. THE SURROUNDING PROPERTIES ARE LARGELY WOODED AS WELL, THE GAMBLE WOULD MOSTLY BE HIDDEN BY TREES.

6. Actions the applicant will undertake to mitigate the negative effects, if any, of the proposed special exception.

I DO NOT SEE ANY NEGATIVE EFFECTS OF THIS GARAGE, I AM NOT DESTROYING VALUABLE HARDWOODS AND IT WILL ONLY INCREASE MY PROPERTY VALUE, THEREFORE ALSO MCREASING THE PROPERTY VALUES OF MY NEIGHBORS, IT WILL ALSO ALLOW ALL OF OUR VEHICLES TO BE PARKED INSIDE INSTEAD OF SITTING IN THE DRIVEWAY

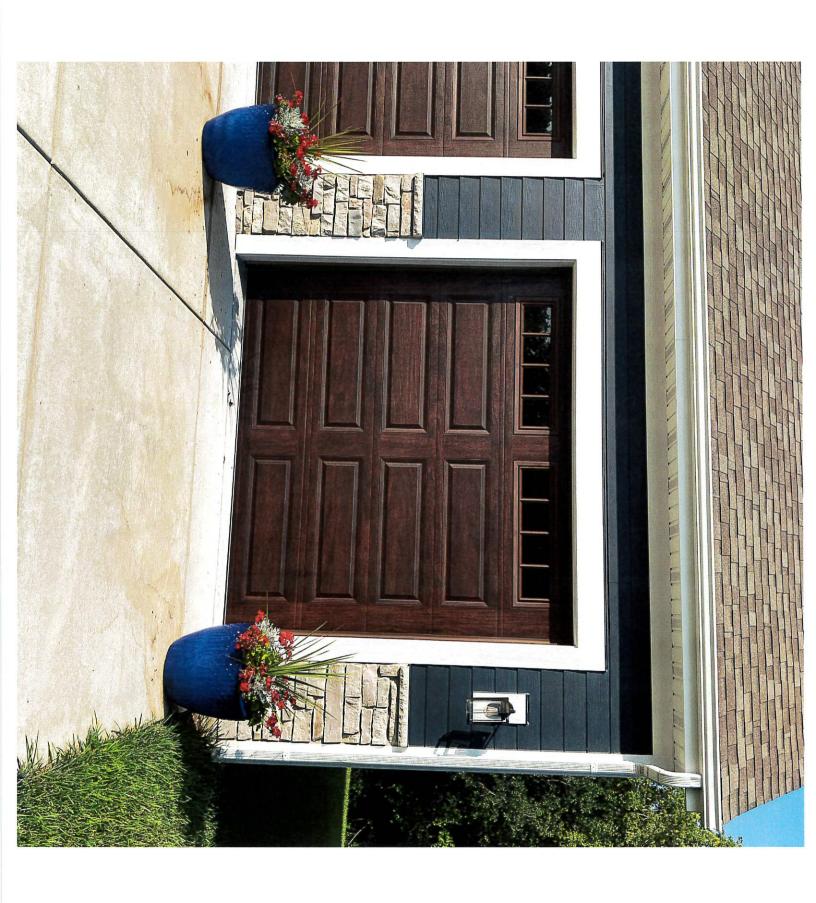

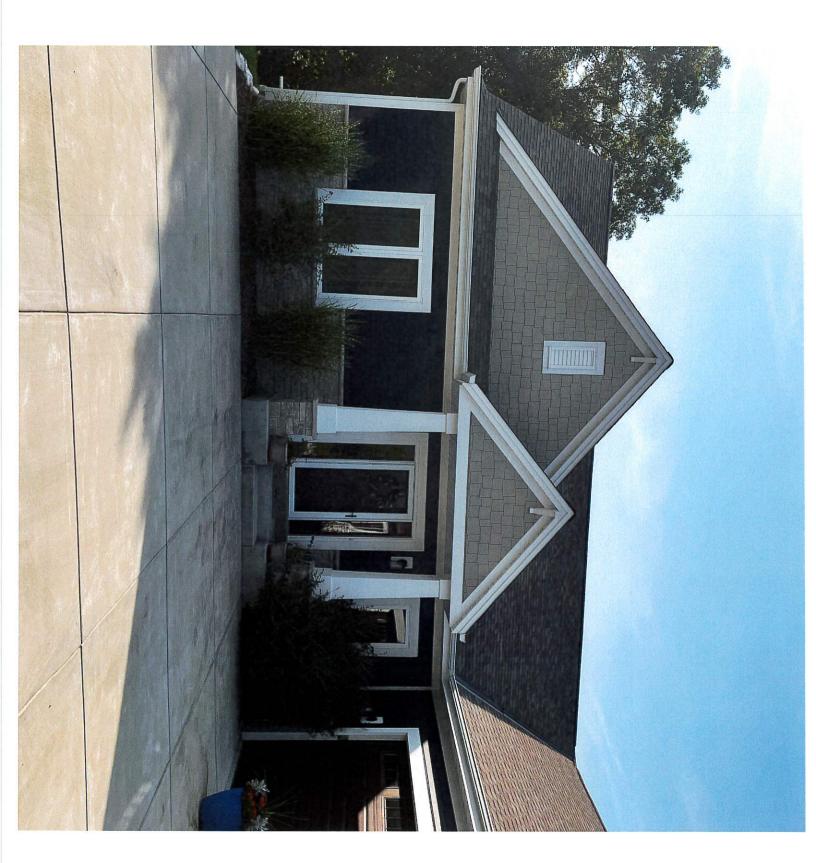
